



Football Priority Seating Information Important Points to Note

1. 2014 Football Priority Seating:

A. The Blue Zone

Priority season tickets in the Blue Zone require a minimum MAC gift of \$500 per seat.

B. The Red Zone

Priority season tickets in the Red Zone require a minimum MAC gift of \$425 per seat.

C. The Gold Zone

Priority season tickets in the Gold Zone require a minimum MAC gift of \$250 per seat.

D. The Orange Zone

Priority season tickets in the Orange Zone require a minimum MAC gift of \$125 per seat.

E. The Green Zone/Family FunZone

Season tickets in the Green Zone and Family FunZone do not require a MAC gift to purchase.

2. Football Season Ticket Renewals; Renew Your Season Tickets and Make Your MAC Gift Online at WVUGAME.com:

A. MAC Annual Fund/Priority Seating Season Ticket Renewals

Your 2013 season ticket seat locations are noted on the 2014 season ticket renewal form. The MAC annual gift and football season ticket renewal deadlines are Thursday, May 15. Failure to meet these deadlines may result in the forfeiture and potential relocation of your season tickets and parking passes.

Fans are encouraged to renew their season tickets and make their MAC annual gift online at WVUGAME.com. Detailed instructions for online ticket renewals and online giving can be found in the letter accompanying the season ticket renewal statement.

Funds generated from the MAC Annual Giving and Season Ticket Priority program are utilized to provide the necessary resources for student-athlete scholarships, academic support services, recruiting, athletic training and nutrition, and improve facilities for our 18 varsity programs. It is essential that donors renew their MAC membership at the same annual giving level (or higher) in order to retain season ticket and parking locations for the 2014 football season. Seat locations and parking assignments are contingent upon meeting all MAC annual giving requirements and applicable deadlines.

B. Requests for Additional Season Tickets

Your 2014 season ticket order form includes a separate application should you wish to request additional season tickets. Additional season ticket requests are not guaranteed, and applications will not be processed or rejected until June. Credit cards will not be charged for additional season ticket requests unless additional seats are available for your purchase. Should your additional order be accepted (based on availability and MAC priority), you may be required to make an additional MAC gift at that time.

C. The Green Zone

Season tickets in the Green Zone do not require a MAC gift to purchase. Green Zone seats are available only on a renewal basis at this time. Green Zone sections may be subject to MAC gift priority seating gift requirements in future years.

D. Family FunZone

The Family FunZone is an alcohol-free, family-friendly section for season ticket holders at Milan Puskar Stadium. Season tickets in the Family FunZone are located in section 133 and cost \$365. Family FunZone tickets do not require a MAC gift to purchase.

Renewing season ticket holders in this section will have the option of maintaining their seats in this section or having them moved to section 132. Please attach a note to your season ticket renewal form indicating your preference.

Existing WVU football season ticket holders in other sections of Milan Puskar Stadium may also request to have their existing seats relocated to the Family FunZone. All requests must be made in writing and sent to the Mountaineer Ticket Office with your renewal form and payment.

Any remaining season tickets in the Family FunZone section will go on-sale to the general public in June. Specific details will be announced at a later time.

E. Seat Changes/Upgrades

Season ticket holders must submit seat upgrade and change requests in writing to the Mountaineer Ticket Office. To be eligible for seat relocation, the appropriate Mountaineer Athletic Club contribution and season ticket payment must be received by the season ticket priority deadline. Relocation requests are subject to availability and filled based on annual giving levels and total priority points within each giving level. Making a donation above the minimum required "per seat" contribution, or above the minimum donation associated with a section different than your current section does not quarantee relocation.

3. New Football Season Ticket Applications:

A. New 2014 MAC Members/Priority Season Tickets

Priority season tickets cannot be guaranteed to all NEW donors who make a MAC gift before the May 15 deadline. However, it is certainly the goal and Intention to assign sideline seating (lower deck or upper deck) to all who join the MAC and order priority season tickets before the deadline.

Seats that are available after renewal orders are processed will be assigned to new MAC members beginning with the Mountaineer Scholar annual giving level to the Buckskin annual giving level based on Priority Points within each annual giving level (starting at mid-field and allocating toward the goal line). Please see points 1-A, 1-B 1-C and 1-D in regard to Blue, Red, Gold and Orange Zone priority seating.

Please note: All new MAC members who requested season tickets in 2013 received season tickets. It is suggested that fans interested in obtaining new season tickets for the 2014 season should join the MAC to maximize their opportunity at obtaining season tickets. An effort will be made to accommodate all new MAC members with 2014 season tickets, but tickets cannot be guaranteed.

B. Blue and Red Zone Season Tickets

Due to high demand and minimal attrition, it is unlikely that all new donors who give at the \$500 and/or \$425 minimum per seat giving level will receive Blue and/or Red Zone seating in 2014. Seating will instead be assigned to these donors in the best-available locations in the Gold, Orange and Green Zones, respectively based on their MAC donor priority and associated giving level.

C. New 2014 Green Zone Season Tickets

If available, new Green Zone season tickets will be offered for sale in June after all season ticket renewal orders and new MAC donor priority orders are processed.

4. 2014 Football Priority Parking:

A. Football Parking

 Parking passes will be assigned based on availability and Mountaineer Athletic Club priority guidelines.

B. Light Blue Lot

- Mountaineer Scholar level members may request up to three passes.
- Gold Scholar level MAC members may request up to two passes
- Blue Scholar and Champion level members who had Light Blue passes last season may maintain priority on up to two passes.

C. Silver Lot

- All available parking in the Silver Lot, including reserved spots, will require purchase of a parking pass for the 2014 season.
- Mountaineer Scholars and Gold Scholars have priority to request up to two Silver Lot passes, one of which is a reserved spot.
- Blue Scholars may request up to request up two Silver Lot passes, one of which may be a reserved spot if available.
- Existing Champions have priority to renew one Silver Lot pass.
- New donors at the Champion level and below are not eligible to purchase a Silver Lot pass.

D. Blue Lo

- Mountaineer Scholars may request up to four Blue Lot passes.
- Gold Scholars and Blue Scholars may request up to three Blue Lot passes.
- Champion MAC members may request up to two Blue Lot passes.
- Director level donors may request one Blue Lot pass.

E. Brown Lot

 Existing MAC members who had a Brown Lot pass in 2013 may maintain priority on one Brown Lot pass.

F. Green Lo

 MAC members at the Blue Club level and above may request one Green Lot pass.

G. RV Parking


- Mountaineer Scholars, Gold Scholars, Blue Scholars and Champion level MAC members may request one RV pass in the Blue, Light Blue Aux, Red, Green and Coliseum lots.
- Captain level MAC members and above may request one RV pass in the Green Lot.
- Blue Club level MAC members and above may request one RV pass in the Coliseum lot.
- RV parking is not available in the Silver Lot.
- Front Row RV parking in the Light Blue lot is currently sold out and available on a renewal basis only to Blue Scholar members and above.
- Front Row RV parking in the Blue Lot is available at Mountaineer Scholars and Gold Scholars and will be allocated based on MAC giving level and priority points.
- Interested MAC members are encouraged to contact the MAC office at 1-800-433-2072 to have their name added to a waiting list for Front Row RV parking.

H. ADA Parking

 ADA parking is available on a season basis in the Blue, Brown and Silver lots. Please contact the Mountaineer Ticket Office for information on obtaining ADA parking for the 2014 season.

Away Game Football Ticket Sales; Individual Game Ticket Sales; Safeguard Tickets and Parking Passes:

- All 2014 football season ticket holders and MAC donors will receive an Away Game, Mini Package and Individual Home Game ticket order form in June. Ticket availability is limited, and requests will be prioritized by MAC annual giving level and Priority Points within each giving level. Individual game tickets may not be available for all games.
- The Mountaineer Ticket Office is not responsible for lost, destroyed or stolen tickets and/or parking passes. It is recommended that fans safeguard their tickets and parking passes to avoid fees associated with replacing or reprinting tickets and/or parking passes.
